A city correction officer held back tears yesterday after a Queens jury cleared him of charges he recklessly shot at a fellow motorist after an altercation on the Grand Central Parkway.

The defendant, *[redacted]*, was driving west at about 5:20 a.m. on April 10, 2003, when his car was struck by a 1996 Jeep Cherokee.

Cambria followed the other motorist, *[redacted]* and flashed his badge at him before the two vehicles pulled off the highway, authorities said.

Prosecutors charged that Cambria banged on the driver's window with his 9 mm Glock pistol, then fired four shots at the Jeep as it sped off.

Cambria testified that *[redacted]* had tried to run him down before he opened fire.
